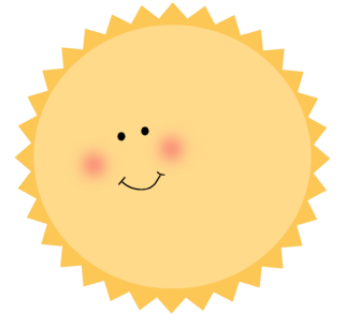


Beaver County
