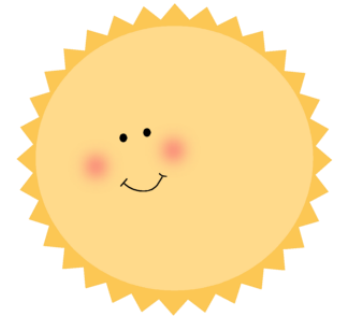


Garfield County
