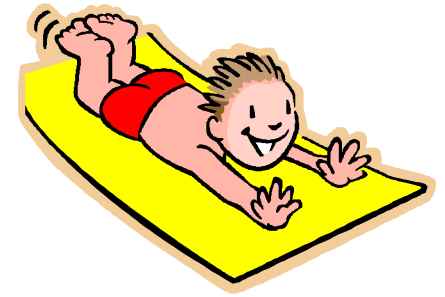


# Iron County Summer Activities Guide
