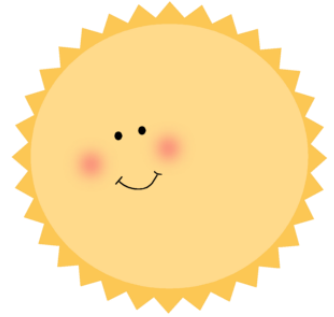


Sanpete County
