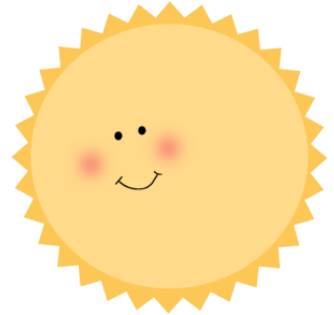


Sevier County
